- Make sure to pick up a Players Club Awards Card and inquire about a free birthday round at golf shop counter.

Tartan Niners League Adopted Rules 4/2019

(Remember, we are NOT a USGA league.)

- **Play READY Golf!! Be prepared for next shot. Please mark your ball.** e.g. a letter or other
- **On the tee box:** Tee off between the red tee markers & no further than 2 club lengths behind them
- **No maximum strokes per hole in this league:** Bad hole? Play it and record strokes.
- **You MUST count every stroke** including whiffs, and you MUST putt out. (No gimmes!)
- **If you QUIT a hole or don't putt out,** continue to play, BUT your ENTIRE game is void for ALL STATS that week
- **Winter Golf Rules apply through May** This means that if your ball lands on a patch of bare ground (or snow), where there should be grass, then you can move your ball to the closest grass, no closer to the hole

- **Rule to Putt with flag stick in or out while on the green** - players choice and no penalty if ball hits the flag.
- **Rule adopted to drop ball from knee height** 2019 USA standard
- **Rule for lost ball: Maximum 3 minutes to search for ball.**

Play provisional if you think ball is lost

Drop the ball 2 club lengths from where you think it was lost and add a stroke

- **Rule for Hole 16 at Oak Marsh:** You **MUST** play every shot & **IF** the ball goes into the gully, you can drop on the other side with a 1 stroke penalty. **NOTE:** there is **NO** marked drop zone
- **Unplayable ball in a bunker:** Note: You decide if it's unplayable, e.g., buried into the side

No penalty to lift ball, rake and replace ball when in foot or hoof print

One shot penalty in bunker: player may drop ball lateral or back -on-the-line from the flag stick. Player may also choose to go back to where the previous shot was played.

Two shots penalty to drop outside of bunker in a line from flag stick to where your ball lies in bunker

- **Unplayable ball Events. All water hazards are RED staked.** If your ball goes into the water, a new ball may be dropped within 2 club lengths from where the ball entered and take a 1 stroke penalty.

No penalty for **Casual Water (e.g., puddle or water in bunker)**, move ball to nearest dry area, no closer to the hole.

Under a bush or too close to tree: if unplayable, drop 2 club lengths away for 1 stroke penalty

Hit power line at Oak Marsh: you must hit another ball from where you originally hit (with no penalty stroke).

Cart Path: If ball is on path or too close so you must stand on path to hit it, you may drop the ball on the grass near that side of the path and no nearer to hole with no penalty.

--if you wish, you may play a ball from cart path or stand on path to make your shot

--If you take relief from cart path, you **MUST** not stand on path to take your shot
